## FROM WASATCH FRONT WASTE AND RECYCLING DISTRICT!

The team and I would like to welcome you to the Wasatch Front Waste and Recycling District (WFWRD) service area.

WFWRD proudly serves over 86,000 households in the municipalities of Brighton, Copperton, Cottonwood Heights, Emigration Canyon, Herriman, Holladay, Kearns, Magna, Millcreek, Taylorsville, White City and portions of Murray and Sandy, along with the unincorporated areas of Salt Lake County. Some additional non-residential customers are served through contracts and interlocal agreements.

In addition to weekly curbside garbage and recycling collections, we provide many other services. Please refer to the enclosed packet or visit [info@wfwrduah.gov](mailto:info@wfwrduah.gov) for more information.

The basic service at \$26.00 a month includes one garbage can and one recycle can (more cans are available for an additional fee). There is a new can fee for all newly built homes in the amount of \$140.00.

We bill quarterly through 2025 and changing to monthly January 2026

Go Paperless and set up auto-pay once you receive your first bill. Pay by mail, in person, or online through Xpress Bill Pay. Here are some helpful customer tips to ease the process of waste and recycling collections:

- Have the cans out for collection no later than 7:00 AM the scheduled day of service
- Remove the cans from the street within 12 hours of your pickup
- Please place the can at least 3 feet from other cans, mailboxes, trees, fences, cars, and any other object.
- Avoid placing the cans under trees or basketball standards
- Please don't overfill the cans. Items should not stick out above the top more than a couple of inches.
- Do not put hot ashes in the can, they start fires and will cause damage
- Recycle everything that you can to help keep costs low by saving on landfill costs

# Recycling | Green Waste | Garbage Can Etiquette

Your cans may not be collected if they do not meet the requirements below

Keep your cans at least three feet away from trees, vehicles, street signs, mailboxes, basketball hoops, and other cans



Do not overload the can. The lid should close all the way or almost all the way, with nothing sticking out



No hot ashes, fireworks, or embers in the can



Place the can out by 7:00 AM on the day of service



# TAKE ADVANTAGE OF YOUR NEW SERVICES!

## Garbage Collection Services

Residents receive weekly curbside garbage collection. We also provide collection services to parks, libraries and other non-residential sites. A second can is available for an additional [fee](#).

## Recycle Collection Services

Residents can recycle paper, cardboard, plastics, aluminum, and tin. The first blue recycle can is available for no additional charge and emptied every week on the resident's regular collection day. A Second can is offered for an additional [fee](#).

## Green Waste Collection Services

For an additional [fee](#), residents can participate in our green waste program. Collected weekly, this program allows subscribers to compost yard waste, fruits/veggies, and more.

## Trailer Rental

Trailers are available to rent for residents to dispose of green waste (leaves, branches, trees, bushes) and bulky items. There is a \$80 rental [fee](#) for a green waste trailer or \$240 for a bulk trailer. Trailers are rented through reservation and scheduled according to availability through our [website](#).

## Glass Recycling Drop-Off Sites

We provide eight central drop-off locations for glass recycling. Check out the Glass Subscription Page on our [website](#) for more information, addresses, and rules for recycling glass.

## Curbside Glass Recycling

Curbside glass recycling is a subscription-based program currently available in several cities. Call our office or check out our [website](#) for more information.

## Seasonal Container Reservation Program

Some residents will be able to take advantage of our yearly collection day for disposal of large bulky items, old prescriptions, electronics, green waste, and more. Residents will be notified one month before their scheduled day.

## Christmas Tree Collection

Curbside Christmas Tree Collection is provided during the month of January. The trees are collected on your regular day and recycled for woodchips on trails and parks.

## Fall Leaf Pick Up

Each October, leaf bags are available at various locations around the District for residents to pick up. Throughout the month of November, trailers are placed at various locations for residents to drop off leaves. For locations, visit our [website](#).

## Curbside Assist Program

Any resident with mobility limitations may request assistance with their weekly collection at no additional charge. We are happy to work individually with any resident requiring assistance. More information [here](#).

## Box Collection Program

A special one-time pick up for moving boxes and packing materials is provided to new residents as part of the service package. This service is scheduled as requested by our residents. Not available to renters.
