

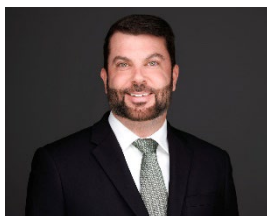


Welcome Message from Our General Manager

Keep your cans at least three feet away from trees, vehicles, street signs, mailboxes, basketball hoops, and other cans



Do not overload the can. The lid should close all the way or almost all the way, with nothing sticking out














No hot ashes, fireworks, or embers in the can



Place the can out by 7:00 AM on the day of service



WFWRD Resident Services Overview

 Garbage Collection	Weekly curbside garbage collection. Second can be available for a fee.
 Recycling Services	Recycle paper, cardboard, plastics, aluminum, and tin. First can free.
 Green Waste Program	Weekly compost collection for yard waste and produce scraps (subscription).
 Landfill Vouchers	One landfill fee waiver per year is provided to residents.
 Glass Recycling	Eight drop-off sites. Curbside subscription available in select cities.
 Annual Clean-Up Day	Some areas get a bulky-item collection day. Notices sent one month early.
 Christmas Tree Collection	Curbside tree collection each January.
 Leaf Bags & Drop-Off Trailers	Leaf bags in October; drop-off trailers in November.
 Assisted Collection	Curbside assistance for residents with mobility limitations.
 New Resident Box Pick-Up	One-time moving box pick-up for new residents (not renters).
 Can Repair & Replacement	Request repair or replacement for damaged cans.
