## Postcard Billing

In a continued effort to keep costs down and retain reasonable service pricing, WFWRD has identified a cost savings measure that will **save \$190,000 per year** on printing and postage costs. Your next WFWRD billing statement will be in the form of a 6" x 4.25" postcard as opposed to a full-size page as we have done in the past.

This simple change will also reduce the amount of paper and resources necessary for our customers that want to continue to receive paper bills.

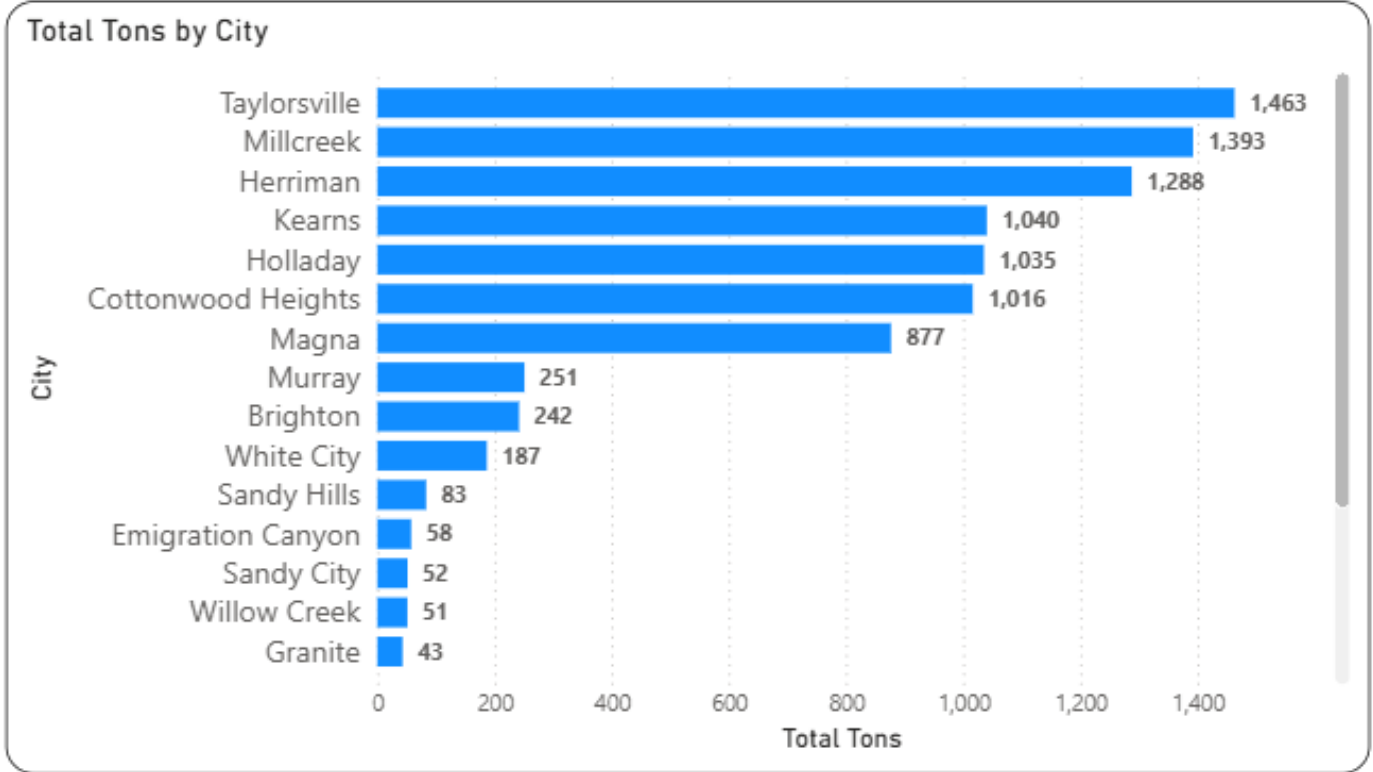

### House Bill 107 – Recycling Facility Transparency Amendments



In response to HB107 requiring political subdivisions to publish information about the collection of recyclable materials twice per year, the chart below includes recycling tonnages collected throughout the District’s service areas from **November 2025 through April 2026** totaling over 9,000 tons!
